PREP: Oct. 1 from 8AM – 6PM

FILMING: Oct. 2 from 12PM – 7PM. RAIN DATE: Oct. 2 from 7AM – 1PM

WRAP: Oct. 2 from 7PM – 8PM

Our production vehicles and various pieces of film equipment will be located on:

- West side of Heward Ave. from Queen St. E. to Carl Stryg Lane.
- East side of Heward Ave. from Carl Stryg Lane to 185 Heward Ave.
- South side of Queen St. E. from Carlaw Ave. to Heward Ave. (to keep clear for picture)
- North side of Eastern Ave. from Carl Stryg Lane to Pape Ave.

We will begin reserving the Heward Ave. & Eastern Ave. sections with cones on Oct. 1 at 8AM. Then reserving the Queen St. E. section on Oct. 1 at 6PM, with vehicles arriving on Oct. 2 at 12PM and departing at 8pm.

Displaced permit parkers affected by our filming activities are kindly asked to park in their driveways (if applicable), surrounding streets, or nearby pay lots. On our filming day, please approach any crew member and ask to speak to Nabil Badine or Sari Miettinen from the Locations Department. We will direct you to available parking and/or reimburse your parking receipt.

We will have Toronto Paid Duty Officers for intermittent traffic stoppages & safety in Carl Stryg Lane during our shoot.

All of our filming & related activities are undertaken under the authority & approval of the City of Toronto Film & Television Office. ANY INTERMITTANT TRAFFIC STOPPAGES/CONTROL will be conducted under the safe supervision of the Toronto Police Service.
